Joseph Kast served as a seaman apprentice in the Navy on the USS Forrestal from 1969 to 1970 during the Vietnam War.

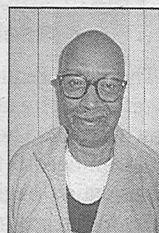
