SCHENECTADY, N.Y. – A ceremonial groundbreaking was held Thursday for a three-story, 50,000 square foot apartment building at 780 Albany Street.

The Joseph L. Allen Apartments are made possible thanks to a \$17.9 million investment and will feature 51 new apartments, filling a critical need for affordable housing in the neighborhood.

The apartments are being built by DePaul Properties, which is a nonprofit organization that provides affordable housing as well as vocational programs and addiction support services.

The project is scheduled to take about 2 years to complete.
