DePaul Celebrates Completion of Rochester View Apartments



DePaul joined with city, state, public and private partners to celebrate the opening of the DePaul Rochester \ ents at an onen house and presentation for the 61-unit community in Henrietta. The DePaul Rochester View Apartments are New York State's first apartment community to offer enhanced supports that accommodate income-eligible tenants who may be Deaf, hard of hearing and those using American Sign Language (ASL).

The DePaul Rochester View Apartments feature state-of-the-art comm design.
