"The residents couldn't believe she was only 1," said Activities Director Tabatha Funderburk said. "Her voice is so beautiful and she is so talented."

A homeschooled student from Pumpkin Center, Mary Lou takes guitar lessons from Diane Bradford. Her teacher let her "mess around" with a harp she had and before she knew it, Mary Lou said she fell in love with the relaxing, calm, peaceful melodies of the instrument.

"I asked for a harp for Christmas and Santa Claus brought me a harp," she said. "I was very surprised and excited. I didn't think I was going to get it."

Mary Lou decided to also learn piano because she felt it would help her improve her ability to read and write new music.

"I play about two hours and 30 minutes each day," she said. "You just get better and better each time you play."

The budding musician especially enjoys sharing her talents with audiences at recitals and with Wexford House residents and the members of her church, Anderson Baptist.

"I want to reach people who don't know Jesus and lead them to Christ with my music," she said. "I also believe music can help people with Alzheimer's by bringing back memories of times they've forgotten. Music is beautiful and it helps people feel better."
