

Events included a spelling bee, shuffle board, a putting green and bean bag toss, bowling, Wii Bowling and word search.


Woodcrest Commons participated in the annual games along with residents from three other DePaul Senior Living Communities, Westwood Commons in North Chili, Glenwell in
