

New affordable apartment complex opens in Geneseo

Geneseo, N.Y. (WHAM) - A new apartment complex opened this week in Geneseo, bringing affordable apartments to people living in Livingston County.

Skybird Landing Apartments was developed in the village of Geneseo and have six buildings with a total of 60 apartments. The apartments are for people or families who live at or below 60 percent of the area median income.

The complex, which is located on Mustang Circle near East South Street, has a laundry room, shared outdoor space, a community room, lounges and office areas.

Half of the new apartments are designated for tenants with a history of homelessness who will have access to supportive services and rent subsidies.

The name "Skybird Landing" is derived from the Geneseo's National Warplane Museum, which is located nearby.

Nearly \$13 million of the \$17 million in funding for the development was subsidized through federal and state Low Income Housing Tax Credits. The New York State Office of Mental Health and Research and Development Authority also gave money to the project.

DePaul operates the Skybird Landing Apartments.
